Second Sunday of Lent

The crisis in Ukraine is a devastating humanitarian disaster, which people in Ireland are responding to with deep compassion. Trócaire is working with Caritas Ukraine and Caritas Poland, who are supporting people both within Ukraine and people who have managed to cross the border. They are providing shelter and essential supplies, including food, blankets, and hygiene supplies. However, Trócaire has appealed that we do not forget the many millions of people who are already facing similar crises around the world and who risk being left with no support as the world focuses on Ukraine It is permissible to use Holy Water Fonts again. It is recommended that we should remain sensitive and respectful (by way of responsible social distancing and optional wearing of masks.) During the Season of Lent. The bishops encourage everyone to return to Sunday and weekday Mass in our churches, welcoming each other back as we gather once more together.

From Easter Sunday, 17th April, Sunday Mass will once again be deemed an essential expression of faith for all in our Church in Ireland. As always, those whose health is vulnerable or who are unwell will not be under any obligation to attend Mass, and should keep themselves safe and pray at home until they are better. The bishops gave much consideration to the shocking developments which have happened in Ukraine in the past fortnight. They commended the outpouring of support and generosity which has been evident in our communities. The bishops ask for continued prayer for the people of Ukraine and for a peaceful resolution to the conflict. They encourage charitable giving through **TROCAIRE** and other agencies.

There will be A nationwide collection in all churches in aid of the people of Ukraine on March 27th next. Please place your donation in an envelope clearly marked Ukraine and drop it into the collection Basket.
